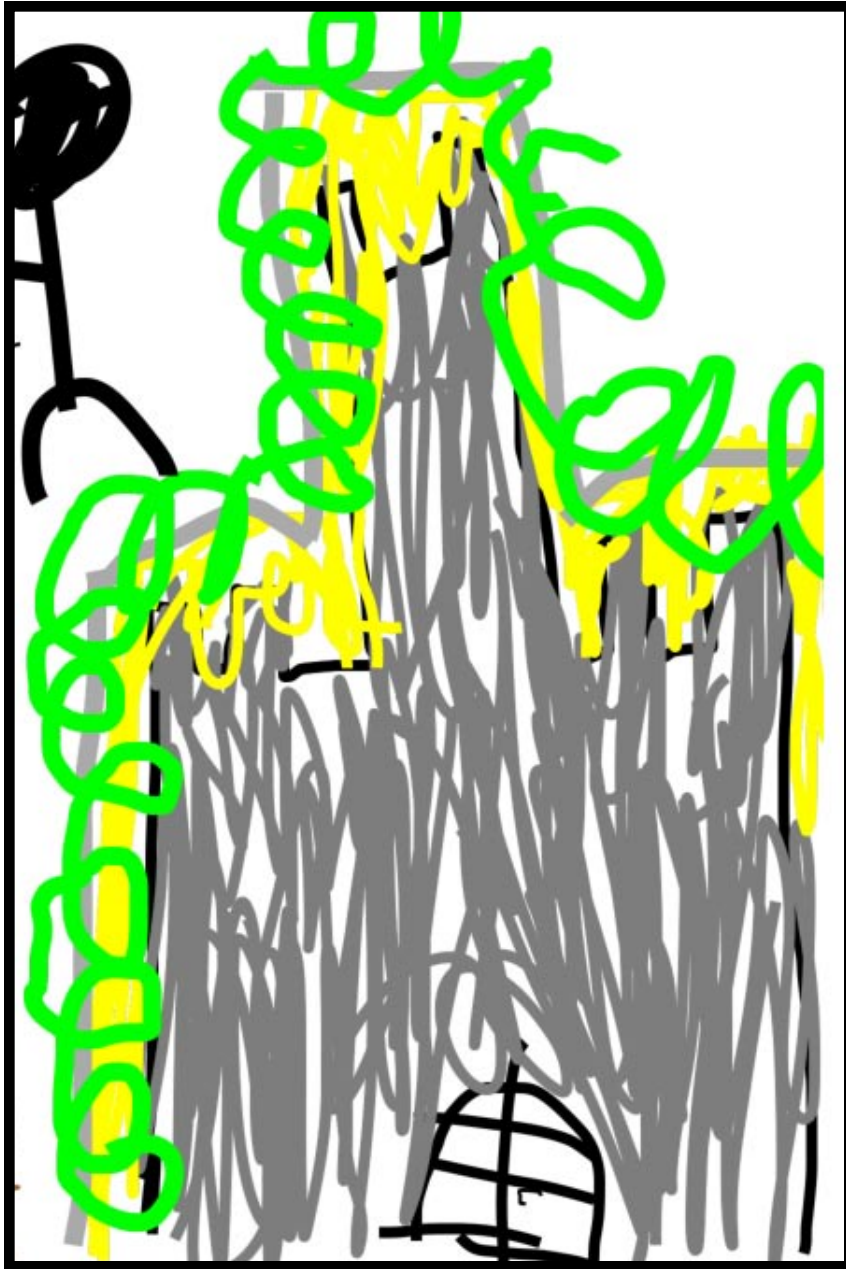

Man in a Minecraft

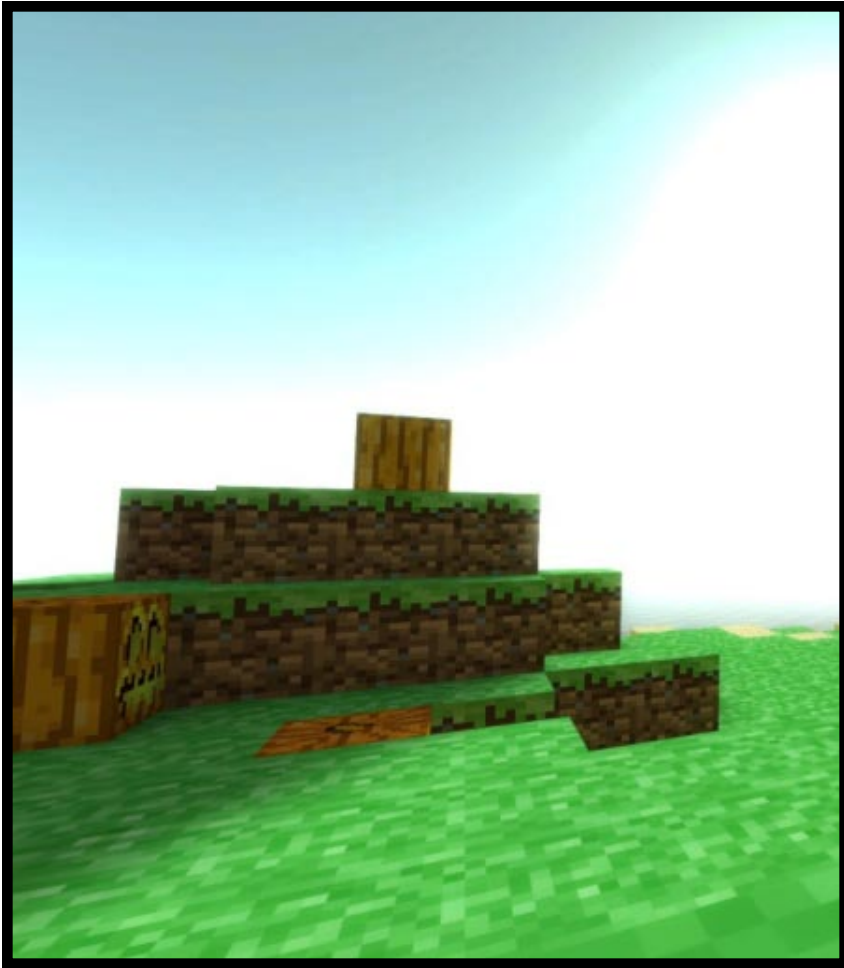

couldn't stand it anymore.

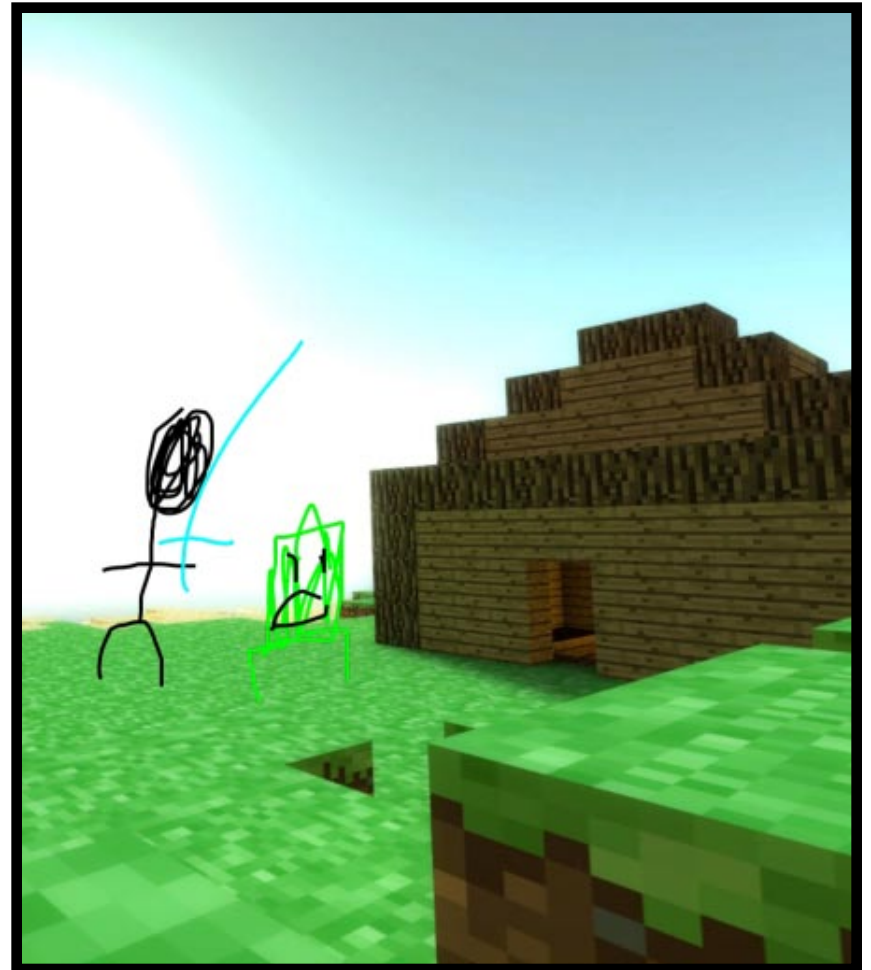
They sent him through the

He found an old ventilized workshop. “Wow,” he said. “Looks like I’m not alone.”



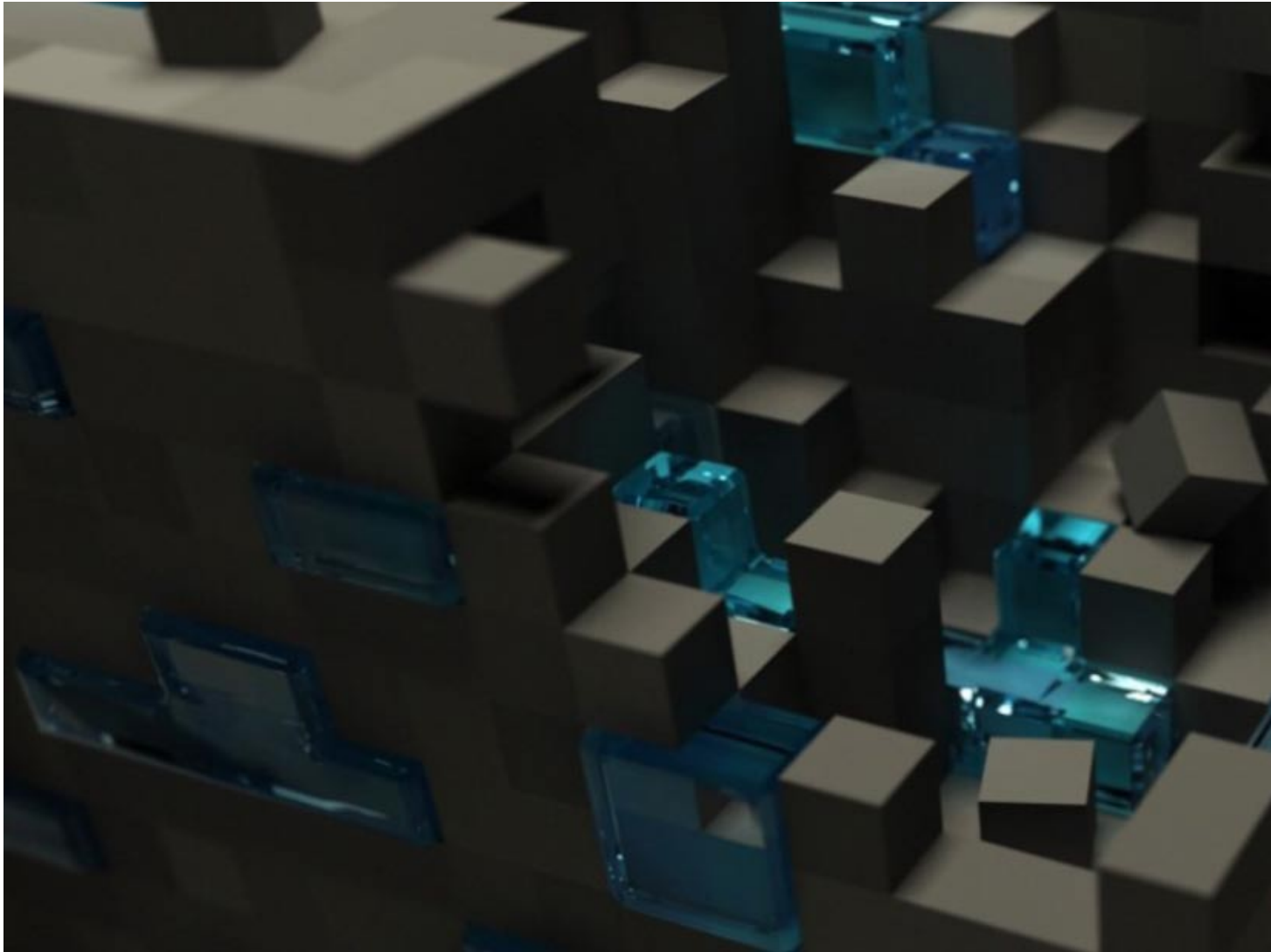
There he saw people who had just finished one of their signs.

He saw a huge town, all made out of squares. “Wow!,” he said.

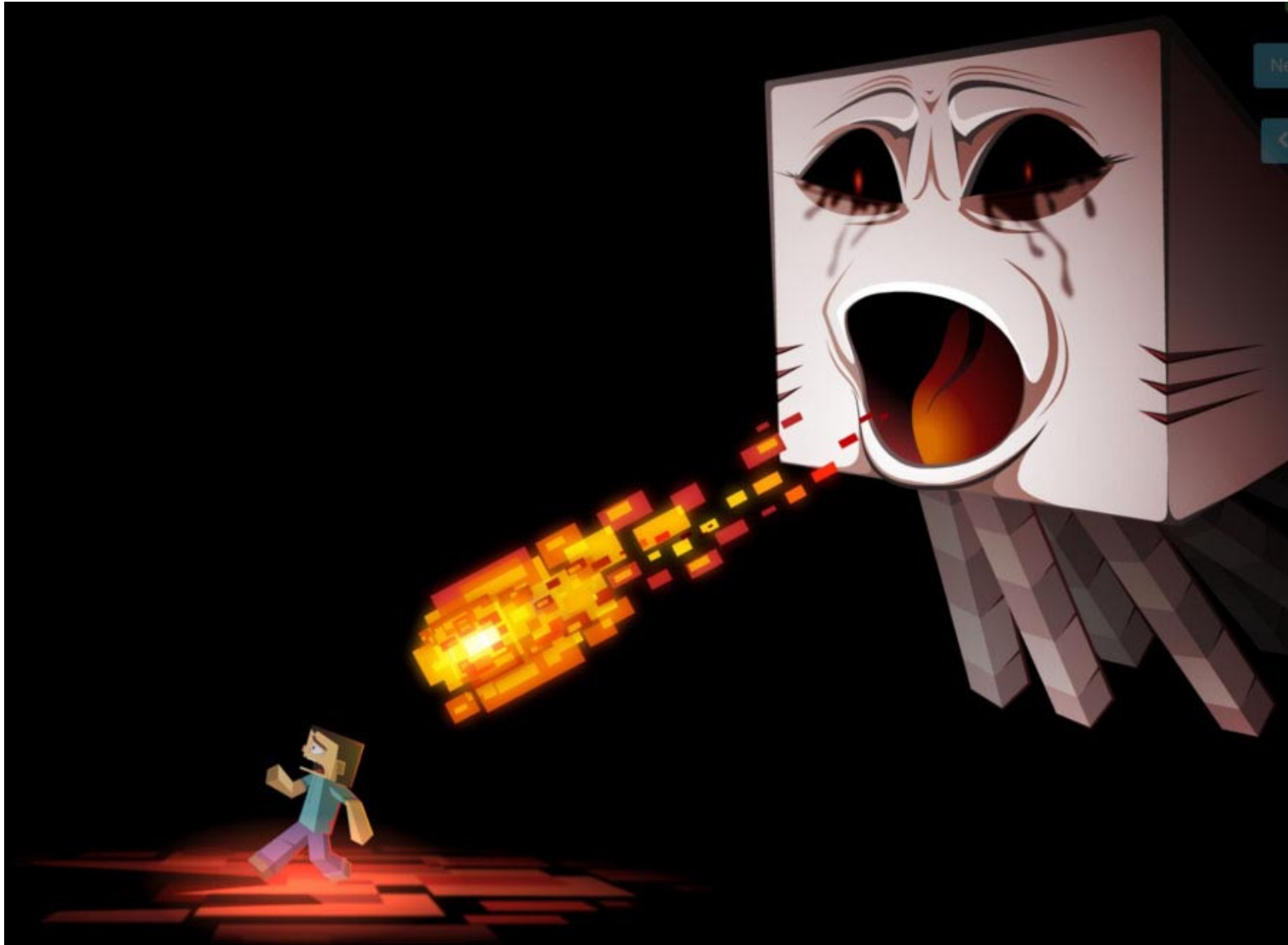


“Another Guard, it’s a giant wolf!”

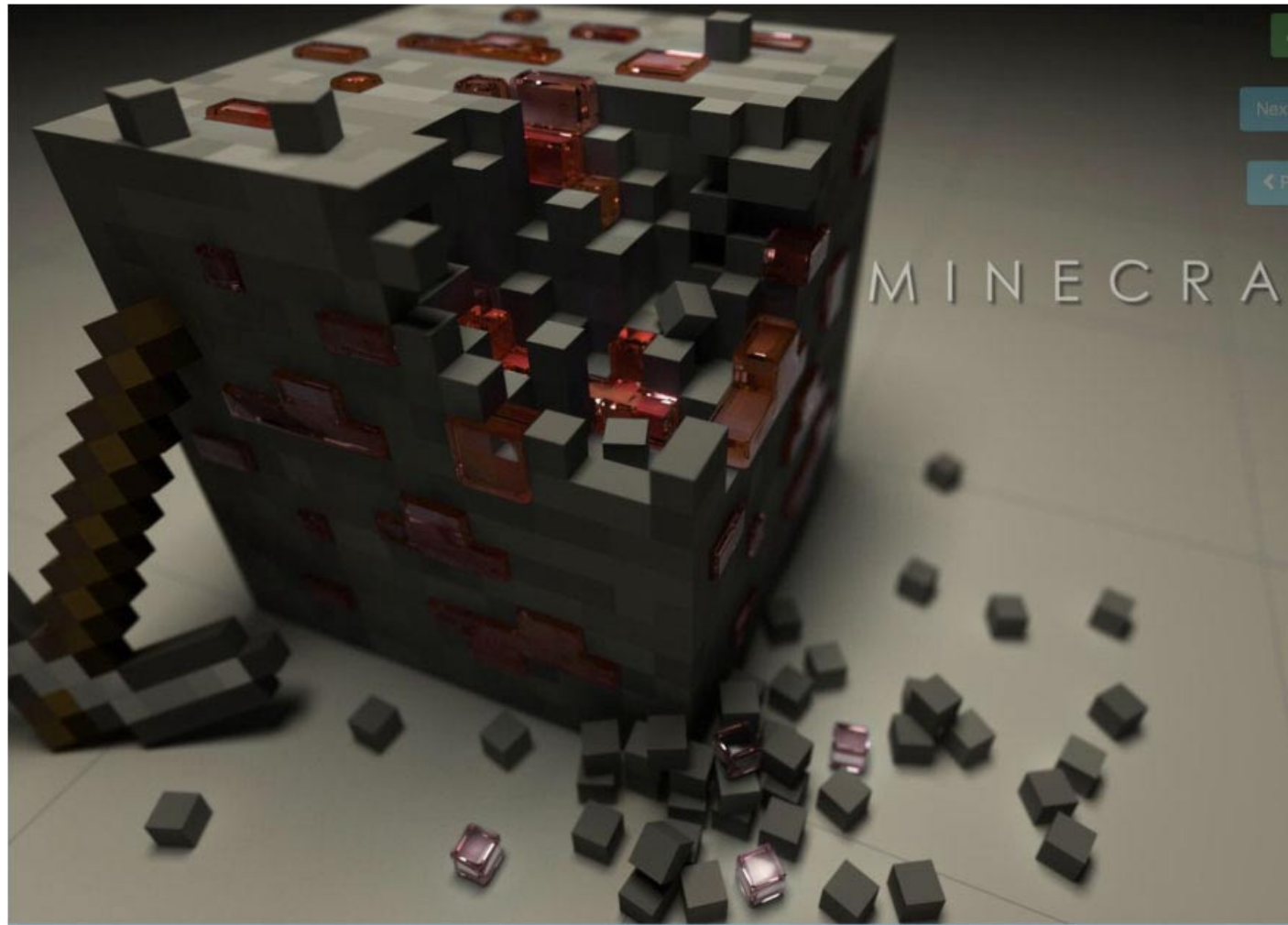
