



When they continued on their quest they stumbled upon a marsh and decided to rest.


When they woke up the next morning, they found their ship was stuck in the marsh and piranhas surrounded them. They scared the piranhas away and




pushed the ship out of the marsh. When they got back out to open ocean, they found an old ship wreck and they remembered that's where The Sea Monster was.



Later, the captain of the sailors remembered hearing about a cursed treasure chest, so they threw it back overboard and sailed to the closest island.




